Management believes in the continual improvement of its environmental performance and the prevention of pollution and, in particular, adopts the best sustainable technologies in the prevention of, and/or optimal reduction in, the sources of pollution, minimising the production of waste and preventing the accidental release of materials that are hazardous to the environment.

Management is committed to reducing environmental impact via the following:

- Compliance with the provisions of current environmental laws and regulations.
- Examination of the factors that characterise their activities, selecting the most significant and recording their effects.
- Control and containment of emissions.
- Minimisation of produced waste.
- Optimisation of the use of raw materials and energy.
- Prevention of accidental emissions.
- Awareness-raising, education and training of personnel.
- Cooperation and communication with local authorities and the local community.

In the case of new business activities, the company favours, at the outset of the planning stage, the most innovative solutions in the prevention and control of the effects on the environment, and organises construction sites and the management of work practices in such a way as to ensure optimal environmental protection.

Management reviews, establishes and revises environmental objectives and targets using a suitable internal audit system.

Management provides its personnel with adequate tools and training programmes to achieve the set environmental protection objectives and provides those with direct influence the authority to promote, offer and verify correct application of the Environmental System.

The Environmental Policy is reviewed and revised during the Management Review, which is carried out at least on an annual basis. The Environmental Policy aims to be commensurate with the nature, scale and environmental impacts of production process activities.
